



#### The CTC Project:

Aims to develop local flexible manufacturing of green personalized products close to the customer (CTC) in terms of features offered, place of fabrication, time to deliver, and cost. Implementation envisions a "green factory behind a glass pane" directly in the Shopping Mall, where the customer witnesses the manufacturing of its personalized furniture....

#### Role of McNally & Finlay Ltd

- Development of Original Concept (based on our existing production system and research).
- I worked closely with SUPSI in the formal application preparation and consortium member selection.
- McNally & Finlay is providing the industrial expertise on cabinet manufacturing, and exploitation models available.
- CTC Project has an EU Budget Contribution of €4,000,000
- Innovawood are consortium members of CTC.



#### **Expected results**

- 1) Formalized Design Approach and related software technologies to empower "design to manufacturing in one step"
- 2) Standardized mini-factory Production System Model
- 3) The CTC woodworking machining system
- 4) A CTC Green Label.



## Wider Industry Involvement

- Very active in industry and academic networks and advocacy.
- Member of Steering Group for the Monaghan Furniture Committee. This is the only active furniture network in Ireland.
- We plan to re-activate the Irish National Furniture Manufacturers Association in May 2014 which has lapsed since the Economic Crisis.
- We organise collaborative trade exhibitions and work with local government on common issues.
- We are pressing national government to proactively engage with industry in the implementation of the EU Timber Regulations. The improvement and proper implementation of these Regulations could have a hugely beneficial effect on European domestic manufacturers who source and manufacture ethically. I've been involved in information dissemination to the wider public through articles in national news media.
- I formed a local cooperative furniture retail outlet for small local manufacturers which operates from McNally & Finlay premises in Monaghan.
