Business Plan for Wood Sector

Duration: 4 days

This course is proved by National Institute of Wood,. In national Qualification system it belongs to Level 1(diploma).

The course is available for managers from small and medium enterprises.

The aim of this programme is to train the small and medium size enterprises managers in the complex process of drawn up and applying of the business plan including management activities and funding capture.
